Social Emotional Learning (SEL)

National Research*

Nine out of ten teachers nationwide believe social and emotional skills can be taught and benefits students.

Each year, Learners complete about 25 customized, high-interest individual projects, 5 group projects and 1 school-wide project to meet 90+ Common Core Standards.



Project-Based Learning (PBL)

Students demonstrate better problem-solving skills in PBL than in more traditional classes and are able to apply what they learn to real-life situations.

Across Math, Language Arts, Science, and Social Studies, Bloom360 Learners demonstrate proficiency (average 3.97 out of a 4-point scale) and can apply the skills they have learned.



Growth

Supporting students' SEL development produces an 11% gain in grades and test scores. Studies show that social and emotional competency is more predictive of academic and career achievement than IQ.

Bloom360 Learners know themselves and their strengths. They use their strengths in school, home, and work environments to collaboratively solve problems, gain self confidence, and realize the many options they have ahead.



Long Term Impact

Growth in occupations that require mastery of social and emotional skills has outpaced growth of all other occupations. Eight in 10 employers say social and emotional skills are the most important and yet also the hardest skills to find.
