development produces an **11%
gain in grades and test scores.**
Studies show that social and
emotional competency is more
predictive of academic and
career achievement than IQ.

Growth in occupations that
require mastery of social and
emotional skills has outpaced
growth of all other
occupations. **Eight in 10
employers say social and
emotional skills are the most
important** and yet also the
hardest skills to find.



Meaningful moments underscore the importance of providing Learners with the right environment, a trusted team of guides and high-interest opportunities to encourage growth. These moments add up to powerful stories of perseverance, self confidence, and unlocking options for their futures.

A few moments are highlighted below.



Trusted adults who take the time to know you, listen to you and understand you is vital in feeling safe and ready to learn.



Sharing joy with super dog Stella after making her a comfy dog bed as a project. (Notice Stella's paw and appreciative gaze.) Schoolwork doesn't have to be memorization and worksheets.



Field trips offer opportunities to learn to fish, kayak, hike and enjoy nature with a trusted community of Learners, the Bloom360 team and volunteers.



Weekly therapeutic riding at nearby Willow Creek Ranch is a favorite activity and also supports Learners' physical, social-emotional and academic growth.



Learners complete an average of 6 school-wide projects each year to practice collaboration, planning, teamwork, communication and entrepreneurship. These are critical skills employers report are the hardest to find.



The only school in southeastern Wisconsin with a full-time music therapist, Learners enjoy individualized music therapy and two annual showcase concerts where they plan the entire program.



Learners can earn a high school diploma with the support and guidance they need to fully realize their strengths and prepare for their next steps.
